Spring Grant Cycle

Deadline to submit a grant application is noon on April 1, 2022.

The deadline for the completed grant applications to be submitted to the <u>principal for approval is March 25th</u>.

Submit applications in MTFEE's mailbox in the main office of your school.

Please note: staff can submit multiple grant applications per cycle.

Before Starting Your Grant Application...

Run your grant idea by the school principal.

 This will save time and ensure that your idea is not covered under another budget, etc.

Grant Review Process

- * Responsibility to donors to approve innovative grant applications.
- * Rigorous grant review process, that is <u>not subjective</u>.
- Have a "grant committee" that utilizes a grading system, similar to a rubric that the teachers use, to fairly evaluate the applications.
- After committee members have an opportunity to review them individually, they <u>come together</u> as a group to discuss them.
- Meet with superintendent and curriculum, as well as technology
 when applicable.
- Committee <u>presents their recommendations</u> to the entire MTFEE board of trustees for final approval.

What Types of Grants Can MTFEE Fund?

- Grant that shows a <u>clear benefit</u> to Millstone Township students' education.
- Grant that is <u>not currently being implemented</u>.
- Grant that is beyond the scope of the general budget, which depends on the budget for any given year. It should be something that is not currently covered under the BOE budget. MTFEE does not supplement the district budget.
- Grant cost that is reasonable for the scope of the project and number of students that will benefit.
- There is no other funding available (i.e. state or federal, etc.) for that grant.

Grant Proposal Checklist

- ❖ Be sure to check it out on MTFEE's website...
- Am I submitting the application by the deadline?
- Does it contain all of the appropriate signatures, including technology (if applicable)?
- Are all sections filled out completely?
- Are the implementation details clearly defined?
- Are the objectives clearly and concisely defined?
- Is the budget plainly defined?
- Does the proposal submission contain the appropriate back-up documentation about the program and budget details?
- Is the proposal timeline clearly laid out?
- Is the method for evaluating the proposal effectiveness detailed enough?
- Does the grant show a clear benefit to Millstone Township students' education?
- Is the grant I am proposing currently being done?
- Is the grant beyond the scope of the general budget?
- Is there other funding available through other sources, including the general school budget?
- Is the cost reasonable for the scope of the project and for the number of students that will benefit?

Approved Grant Application:

- Was submitted <u>on time</u>.
- Contained all of the <u>appropriate signatures</u> principal, all teachers in grade for grade level grants, technology, etc.
- All sections were completed.
- Objectives were <u>clearly</u> and <u>concisely</u> defined.
- Implementation details were <u>clearly defined</u>.
- Budget was <u>detailed</u>.
- Contained <u>back-up documentation</u> about the program and budget details.
- Proposal timeline was <u>clearly laid out</u>.
- Method for evaluating proposal effectiveness was detailed.
- Showed a clear benefit to Millstone Township students' education.
- Was <u>not currently being done</u>.
- Was <u>beyond the scope of the general budget</u>, which depends on the budget for any given year.
- No other funding was available through other sources, including the general school budget.
- Cost was reasonable for the scope of the project, to meet the objectives, as well as for the number of students that will benefit.

Grant Awards - How They Work

- Grants are awarded once a school year in the spring.
- It's a surprise! The "grant patrol" surprises those staff members with balloons, big check and cow bells.
- Staff who do receive a grant award, also get a letter with next steps.
- Staff who do not have grant application approved, receive a letter from MTFEE. They can re-submit next grant cycle.

In closing

- MTFEE trustees work hard to fundraise and want to approve as many grant applications as possible, as that's our mission without compromising our system or quality of what is approved.
